**October 2010: A one-story, one-bay garage, constructed ca. 1900, is located east of the dwelling. The garage is set on a poured concrete foundation and is of concrete-block and tile construction. It is capped by a sloping roof. The east elevation is missing and wood framing has been inserted into the structure.**

**October 2010:** Constructed in 1893 by Albert W. Chappell, this two-story, two-bay Queen Anne-style single-family rowhouse is one of four dwellings constructed from the same permit (#2341). The dwelling is composed of a two-story main block with a full-height, projecting rectangular bay on the façade and a two-story ell extending from the rear (east) elevation. Set on a solid brick and concrete foundation, this brick dwelling is faced with stretcher-bond brick on the façade (west elevation). A sloping roof pierced by an interior brick chimney caps the dwelling and is complemented by a molded metal cornice and brick corbelling. The façade is pierced by a single-leaf, paneled wood door with lights accented by a single-light transom and single and paired 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete sills and rock-faced concrete lintels. Various brick belt courses also span the façade and a four-course brick watertable is located above foundation level. The foundation is pierced by vinyl sliding windows with concrete sills. The rear (south) elevation is fenestrated by 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows and feature concrete sills and two-course, rowlock brick segmental arches.

A two-story brick ell extends from the northernmost bay of the rear (east) elevation and is original. Capped by a sloping roof, this ell is set on a solid foundation. A two-story wood-frame porch, likely original, is located on the east elevation of the ell and has been enclosed with vinyl siding. The porch is fenestrated with 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows and a single-leaf paneled door with lights leading to a wood deck on the second story. The wood deck is supported by square wood posts and is encircled by square wood balusters.

Site Notes:

**October 2010:** This two-story, single-family rowhouse is located on the east side of 11th Street, N.E. and is set back approximately ten feet from the brick sidewalk. The dwelling is adjacent to 1107 H Street and 729 11th Street, N.E. The gravel-filled front yard is marked by immature shrubs and is surrounded by a metal bow and picket fence. A concrete walkway provides access to the primary entrance. The rear yard is surrounded by a tall, wood privacy fence, and a garage and alley are located east of the dwelling.

**October 2010:** Constructed in 1893 by Albert W. Chappell, this two-story, two-bay Queen Anne-style single-family rowhouse is one of four dwellings constructed from the same permit (#2341). The dwelling is composed of a two-story main block with a full-height, projecting rectangular bay on the façade and a two-story ell extending from the rear (east) elevation. Set on a solid brick and concrete foundation, this brick dwelling is faced with stretcher-bond brick on the façade (west elevation). A sloping roof caps the dwelling and is complemented by a molded metal cornice and brick corbelling. The façade is pierced by a single-leaf, paneled wood door with lights accented by a single-light transom and single and paired 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows. All window openings are highlighted by rock-faced concrete lintels. Various brick belt courses also span the façade and a four-course brick watertable is located above foundation level.

The rear (south) elevation is fenestrated by 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows and feature concrete sills and two-course, rowlock brick segmental arches.

A two-story brick ell extends from the northernmost bay of the rear (east) elevation and is original. The ell, which has been parged, is set on a solid foundation and is capped by a sloping roof pierced by a parged interior-end chimney. The ell is fenestrated by 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows in segmentally-arched openings.

Site Notes:

**October 2010:** This two-story, single-family rowhouse is located on the east side of 11th Street, N.E. and is set back approximately ten feet from the brick sidewalk. The dwelling is adjacent to 731 and 727 11th Street, N.E. The landscaped front yard is marked by mature shrubs and a small tree and is surrounded by a metal fence. A brick walkway and brick steps provide access to the primary entrance. The rear yard is surrounded by a tall, wood privacy fence and an alley is located east of the dwelling.

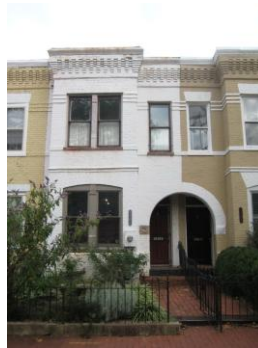
