Exterior & Architectural Notes:

October 2010: This two-story, three-bay single dwelling was constructed in 1929 by owner/builder W.L. Crain. Designed by J.H. Embrey, the building reflects the Colonial Revival style. Set on a solid brick and hollow tile foundation, the brick building is faced with stretcher-bond brick. The sloping roof is obscured by an asphalt-shingled false mansard roof with wide overhanging boxed eaves and a molded metal cornice. The dwelling is fenestrated with 8/1 and paired 6/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows with concrete lug sills and jack brick arches. The main entry, a single-leaf door with a multiple-light transom and multiple-light sidelights, is sheltered by a one-story, two-bay porch. Set on a brick pier foundation infilled with brick, the porch has a half-hipped roof of asphalt shingles supported by fluted Tuscan columns. Concrete steps provide access to the porch, which is edged by a metal balustrade. The basement level contains paired one-light vinyl sliding windows and the secondary elevations are fenestrated with six-light wood casements and single and paired 6/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows. A two-story porch is located on the rear (south) elevation. The shed roof is supported by square wood posts and the porch is edged by a square-post balustrade.

Site Notes:

October 2010: This single dwelling sits on the southeast corner of C Street, N.E. and 12th Place, N.E. on a grassy level lot enclosed by a metal fence. The building has a setback of approximately 10 feet from the public brick sidewalk. The backyard is enclosed by a wood privacy fence.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

October 2010: This two-story, two-bay Italianate-style single dwelling was constructed sometime in the years between 1864 and 1869. The wood-frame building is oriented with its end facing the street and the main entry is located on the west elevation. The dwelling is parged and is capped by a flat roof with a molded wood cornice with modillions and brackets. The dwelling is fenestrated with 2/2, double-hung, wood-sash windows and a single-leaf entry. Window openings on the upper story have molded wood hoods with modillions. A one-story wraparound porch extends from the north elevation to the west elevation. Set on a solid foundation, the porch has what appears to be a half-hipped roof supported by turned wood posts. The porch is edged with a Chinese-style wood balustrade and is ornamented with modillions. A two-story, full-width brick addition was constructed on the south elevation of the dwelling ca. 1921. The addition is capped by a sloping roof pierced by an interior brick chimney with a plain cap. Windows are set in segmental brick arches. A two-story enclosed porch is located on the rear of the addition. Clad with vinyl siding, the porch has a shed roof with overhanging boxed eaves. It is fenestrated with 6/6, double-hung, wood-sash windows.

Site Notes:

October 2010: This single dwelling sits on the south side of the street on a grassy level lot enclosed by a metal chain-link fence. The building has a setback of approximately 10 feet from the public brick sidewalk. The backyard is enclosed by a wood privacy fence.

The records show the property was assessed at \$150 in 1864 for owner William Hurley, whose family had owned it since at least 1854. The assessment increased to \$400 in 1869 when Mary Ward was listed as the owner.

Classical Revival

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

October 2010: This two-story apartment building was constructed in 1926 by owner/builder H&M Lenkins (permit #751). Designed by George T. Santmyers, the apartment building reflects a restrained interpretation of the Classical Revival style. The 12-unit building has a rough rectangular shape and is five bays wide with two full-height, polygonal bays on the façade (north elevation). The brick building sits on a solid concrete foundation and is faced with stretcher-bond brick. The flat roof is edged with metal coping. An exterior brick chimney with a plain cap is located on the rear (south) elevation. Window openings hold single and paired 2/2, double-hung, wood sash (horizontal sash) with concrete lug sills. A molded concrete stringcourse serves as a continuous sill on the first story. Paneled brick spandrels ornament the bays on the façade between the first and second stories. Molded concrete panels featuring paired cornucopia adorn the frieze of the building. The main entry, a double-leaf door with a one-light transom, has a wide surround and a concrete panel above the entry is decorated with festooned swags. The basement level windows hold 1/1, double-hung, wood sash with concrete lug sills. The two-story ell on the rear elevation is constructed of six-course, American-bond brick and has a sloping roof. It is fenestrated with single and paired 2/2, double-hung, wood-sash (horizontal-sash) windows with brick rowlock sills. Openings on the second story of the ell have two-course segmental brick arches. A single-leaf entry is located on the rear (south) elevation and is recessed.

Site Notes:

October 2010: This apartment building sits on the south side of the street on a level lot. The front yard is landscaped and paved concrete surrounds the remaining elevations of the building.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

October 2010: The original Maury school building is two stories high on a raised basement. It consists of a square block with a two-and-a-half-story projecting pavilion on the façade (south) elevation. The building reflects a blend of the Italianate and Romanesque Revival. It sits on a solid foundation that has been parged and is constructed of five-course, American-bond red brick. The building has a flat roof edged by a molded copper cornice with brick corbeling and brick dentils. A large interior brick chimney pierces the roof. Capped by a hipped roof with slate shingles and copper flashing, the upper portion of the tower is fenestrated with segmentally arched louvered vents.

Fenestration consists of segmentally arched 6/6, double-hung, wood-sash windows with brick arches and drip molding. Other ornamentation consists of pressed brick beltcourses. Slightly projecting full-height bays on the east and west elevations contain paired double-leaf entries and are fenestrated with 6/6, double-hung, wood-sash windows with jack brick arches and a tripartite window composed of a 6/6 window flanked by 4/4, double-hung, wood-sash windows and capped by a multiple-light segmentally arched transom with a segmental brick arch. Basement-level windows hold paired segmentally arched four-light wood casement windows with jack brick arches. They are covered with metal screens. Single-leaf entries are located on the rear (north) elevation.

The school was enlarged in 1961 with the construction of a two-story rectangular classroom building with a one-story attached auditorium/cafeteria/multi-purpose room. The new addition is attached the main block by a one-story hyphen. The additions sit on a solid foundation and are constructed of six-course, American-bond brick. The buildings have flat roofs edged with coping and a large exterior brick chimney with a plain cap is located on the west elevation. Fenestration consists of bands of multiple-light metal awning and fixed windows with concrete lug sills and double-leaf doors. The main entry to the building is located on the east elevation and is sheltered by a flat-roof porch. The face of the bay containing the entry is faced with stacked brick. The entry is sheltered by a one-story

Taken from Public School Buildings of the District of Columbia, 1804-1930 by Antoinette J. Lee:

"The original block of Maury School is a typical and well-maintained example of simple red brick school building the Office of the Building Inspector designed during the 1880s and 1890s. It is a two-story building with a tower rising out of the central projecting pavilion of the main façade. The building gains interest from the decorative pressed brick of the segmental arches that serve as window lintels. A string course composed of vertically laid brick placed at an angle is located between the first and second stories. The use of brick patterns at the cornice line and a brick stringcourse at the watertable also serves to relieve the plainness of the façade."

"The John Walker Maury Elementary School was constructed for white students in the Capitol Hill neighborhood. The school was named in honor of the 14th mayor of the City of Washington, who served from 1852 to 1854. Maury was also a prominent lawyer, president of the Bank of the Metropolis, and trustee of Columbian College in the District. By the early 1950s, demographic changes on Capitol Hill shifted, creating a great demand for black classroom space. In 1951, Maury School was transferred to the black school divisions. After the integration of the District's public schools, Maury School served elementary age children of all races in the immediate area of Capitol Hill."

Site Notes:

October 2010: This school sits on the northwest corner of Constitution Avenue, N.E. and 13th Street, N.E. on a gently sloping lot that is enclosed by a metal chain-link fence. Grassy areas with landscaping are located on the southern and eastern sides of the property. The yard in front (south) of the historic school building is terraced with dry-stacked stone

retaining walls. The remainder of the lot is paved with asphalt and serves as a playground and multiple basketball courts.

October 2010: This one-and-a-half-story, three-bay church was constructed ca. 1965 and reflects the Colonial Revival style and the Modern Movement. Set on a solid concrete foundation, the concrete-block structure is faced with stretcher-bond brick. It has an asphalt-shingled front-gabled roof with an overhanging gable on the façade (east elevation). The roof is finished with overhanging eaves and a boxed cornice with returns. A metal stained glass window is located in the upper gable end and has a rowlock brick sill. A metal cross is affixed to the window. The façade is fenestrated with tripled double-leaf paneled wood doors with Colonial Revival-style surrounds of pilasters and a molded entablature. The north (side) elevation is fenestrated with metal jalousie windows. A two-story office building is attached on the rear (west) elevation of the church. It has the same material treatment as the church with a sloping asphalt-shingled roof with a metal-clad parapet and molded metal cornice. The office is fenestrated with metal jalousie windows with brick rowlock sills and a single-leaf flush wood door with a Colonial Revival-style surround composed of a broken pediment and fluted pilasters.
