October 2010: This two-story, two-bay rowhouse was constructed in 1916 by owner/builder George T. and George Y. Worthington. Designed by A.E. Landvoigt, this building is one of four similar rowhouses constructed from the same permit (#5646). The Colonial Revival-style dwelling is constructed of five-course, American-bond brick and is capped by a sloping roof edged with a molded metal cornice. A molded metal stringcourse lines the bottom edge of the frieze. Fenestration consists of 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete lug sills and a single-leaf entry. Openings on the façade (south elevation) are capped by molded pediments and upper-story openings are sheltered by metal awnings. A basketweave brick stringcourse serves as a continuous lintel on the upper story. A one-story, one-bay porch shelters the first story of the dwelling. The shed roof is supported by metal filigree posts. The rear (north) elevation was not accessible.

Site Notes:

October 2010: This dwelling is located on the north side of the street on a level lot enclosed with a metal chain-link fence. The building is set back approximately fifteen feet from the public concrete sidewalk.

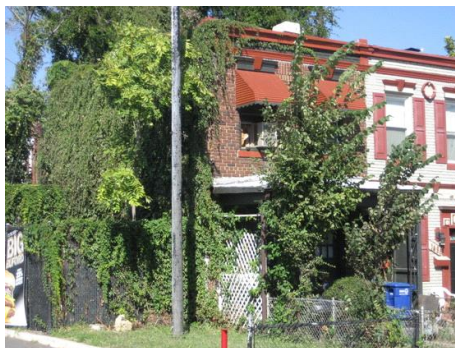

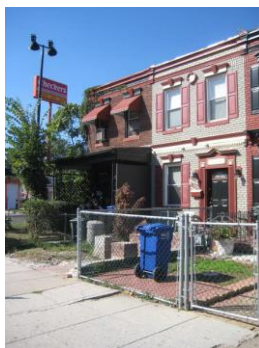

A basketweave brick stringcourse serves as a continuous lintel on the upper story and an intermediate molded metal cornice with dentils and a keystone is located above the first-story openings. The rear (north) elevation was not accessible.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

October 2010: This two-story, five-bay apartment building was constructed in 1925 by owner/builder G.H. Swann. Designed by George T. Santmyers, this building is a restrained interpretation of the Colonial Revival style. Set on a solid concrete foundation that is parged, the building is constructed of six-course, American-bond brick faced with stretcher-bond brick on the façade (south elevation). The 12-unit building has an L-shaped form with a two-story ell on the rear (north) elevation. The flat roof has a parapet with metal coping and is pierced by an interior-side brick chimney with a plain cap. The frieze is ornamented with diamonds laid in brick and a molded metal cornice with a basketweave brick stringcourse is located above the second-story openings. A soldier-brick stringcourse capped by a rowlock brick stringcourse lines the watertable level of the building. The building is fenestrated with 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with brick rowlock sills and soldier-brick lintels and a single-leaf metal-frame class door edged with one-light sidelights and capped by a semicircular transom with a soldier-brick surround. A fabric canopy extends from the entry and shelters the walkway in front of the building. Window openings on the side elevations have brick rowlock sills. The rear elevation was not accessible.

Site Notes:

October 2010: This apartment building is located on the north side of the street on a grassy sloping lot edged by a low brick retaining wall. An asphalt-paved parking area is located to the west of the building. The building is set back approximately fifteen feet from the public concrete sidewalk.

October 2010: This two-and-a-half-story, three-bay single dwelling was constructed ca. 1917. The Colonial Revival-style dwelling sits on a solid concrete foundation and is constructed of five-course, American-bond brick. The sloping roof is obscured by a false mansard roof covered with tile and edged with a molded metal cornice with modillions. Two pedimented metal wall dormers with a denticulated cornice pierce the mansard. Each holds an eight-light wood casement window. Fenestration consists of 6/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows with concrete lug sills and a single-leaf entry with a three-light transom and sidelights. Upper-story openings are sheltered by metal awnings and a one-story, one-bay porch shelters the first story. Set on a brick pier foundation, the porch has a flat roof with a molded and denticulated wood cornice that is supported by metal filigree posts on brick piers. It is edged with a metal balustrade and has a metal awning. The basement level contains 3/3, double-hung, wood-sash windows and a single-leaf entry. A one-story, one-bay enclosed porch is located on the west (side) elevation and was constructed ca. 1940. Set on a brick pier foundation infilled with concrete and six-light wood windows, the porch has a flat roof with a denticulated cornice. The porch is faced with brick and is fenestrated with single and paired 6/6, double-hung, wood-sash windows with concrete lug sills. The rear elevation was not accessible.

October 2010: This dwelling is located on the south side of the street on a level lot edged with a metal fence. The building is set back approximately 35 feet from the public concrete sidewalk.

October 2010: This two-story, two-bay single dwelling was constructed in 1912 by Henry Wahl for Mrs. Julia A. Lauxman (permit #4618). Designed by Julius Wenig, the building blends the Queen Anne style with minimal influence of the Romanesque Revival style. The building is composed of a rectangular main block with a three-sided canted bay on the façade (north elevation) and a two-story ell on the rear (south) elevation. Set on a solid raised concrete foundation, the brick building is faced with stretcher-bond brick. The sloping roof is ornamented with a molded metal cornice. Fenestration consists of 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete lug sills and rock-faced concrete lintels and a single-leaf entry with a semicircular transom. The entry has a gauged brick surround with a keystone and imposts. A molded metal stringcourse lines the lower edged of the frieze and two-course brick stringcourses serve as continuous sills on the façade. A two-story porch is located on the rear elevation. It has a shed roof supported by square woos posts and a lattice balustrade on both stories. No other details were visible.

October 2010: This dwelling is located on the south side of the street on a level grassy lot. The building is set back approximately 35 feet from the public concrete sidewalk. A wood privacy fence encloses the back yard.

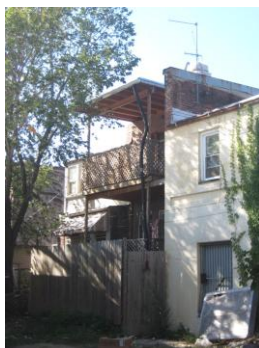

October 2010: This two-story, three-bay commercial building was constructed in 1908 by Jones & Peters Construction Company for the Dickey Brothers. Designed by John C. Deichmann, the building's original use was a feed store (permit #2536). Set on a solid concrete foundation, this brick building is faced with stretcher-bond brick and is capped by a sloping roof with metal coping. The fenestration of the building has been altered on both stories. The first story contains three single-leaf entries with one-light transoms (one in each bay) and large multiple-light fixed and hopper metal windows with brick rowlock sills. The upper story contains 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows that sit on a checkerboard brick spandrel and have a concrete lug lintel. The openings have either been shortened or moved, as brick infill is visible above the windows. October 2010: This two-story, three-bay building was constructed in 1901 by Frank J. Hessler for Henrietta Adams. Designed by Harry B. Davis, the Queen Anne-style building was originally constructed as a store and residence (permit #1938). The building is composed of a triangular main block with a two-story polygonal bay on the northeast corner and two rectangular projecting bays on the east (side) elevation. The brick building sits on a solid concrete foundation and is faced with stretcher-bond brick. It has a sloping roof pierced by three interior brick chimneys with plain caps and is edged with a molded metal cornice with brick corbeling. The corner bay is capped by an asphalt-shingled pyramidal roof with a metal finial. The original entry on the first story of the corner bay and all first-story window and door openings on the east elevation have been boarded with plywood. The main entry is now located on the north elevation and is flanked by one-story projecting bays covered with corrugated metal. A fabric awning spans the north elevation. Upper-story openings hold 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete lug sills and three-course rowlock brick segmental arches. A two-course brick stringcourse serves as a continuous sill on the upper story.

October 2010: This building is located on the southwest corner of Maryland Avenue, N.E. and 15th Street, N.E. The corner lot is paved with concrete and the building is set back approximately twenty feet from the public concrete sidewalk.
