Exterior & Architectural Notes:

May 2009: This two-story building was originally constructed as two attached dwellings, but reads as one singular building with a central entry. The building was designed by architect H.A. Campbell and built in 1898 by George C. Hough for E.E. Berry. The building sits on a solid foundation of concrete and brick. It is constructed of bricks and faced with stretcher-bond brick on the façade (south elevation). The building has a flat roof with a false mansard roof covered with asphalt shingles on the façade. The roof is finished with overhanging eaves, a cornice ornamented with a band of acanthus molding, egg and dart bed molding, and an ornamental frieze decorated with rinceau. The outer edge of each bay is marked by a brick and concrete console that is capped by a finial. The first story is three structural bays wide with a center entry that is marked by a round arch opening with three keystones. The keystone at the top of the arch is decorative and consists of a reeded, triangular-shaped panel with a bead of pearl molding that runs vertically. It is capped by a small piece of ogee-molded concrete. This outer opening holds a single-leaf metal security door. It is flanked by triple storefront windows that are protected with metal security bars. The inner opening leading into the building holds a single-leaf wood door. The upper story of the building is two bays wide. Each bay has its own three-sided oriel that is capped by a hexagonal roof with overhanging flared eaves. The roof of each oriel is topped by a finial. The oriels have an ornamented, boxed cornice with modillions. Each face of the oriels holds a single fixed light, which appears to be wood. The windows are set in narrow egg-and-dart surrounds and have paneled spandrels both above and below the windows.

A tall concrete-block retaining wall is located at the rear of the property and obscures the rear elevation. A two-story, full-width addition is located on the rear elevation. It does not appear on the 1960 Sanborn Insurance Map. Based on its form and materials, it was likely constructed ca. 1985. The addition sits on a solid foundation of concrete blocks and has a slightly sloping shed roof (materials not visible). The addition is clad with vinyl siding and is fenestrated by a single-leaf flush wood door on the second story of the east (side) elevation. A vehicular opening on the rear elevation appears to have a double-leaf door of plywood. No other details were visible from the public alley.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and fronts directly onto the sidewalk. A public alley is located to the rear (north) of the building. The building is attached on the west side to 1324 H Street, NE and on the east side to 1328 H Street, NE.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

May 2009: Constructed in 1893, this three-story, two-bay building is one of two buildings constructed by John H. Nolan. The building is constructed of brick and is set on a solid brick foundation; both are faced with stretcher-bond brick. The west (side) elevation is constructed of American-bond brick. A sloping roof caps the building, though the roofing material was not visible from the public right-of-way. A cornice projects from the façade (south elevation) and is sited above a string course composed of recessed rowlock bricks. An interior-side brick chimney rises from the west (side) elevation of the building and is in a deteriorated condition. The first story of the façade has been altered since construction. The easternmost features a round-headed opening with a soldier brick round-headed arch. The opening shelters the deeply recessed single-leaf paneled wood door. The westernmost bay contains a single-leaf metal-frame glass door, which is flanked by one-light metal sidelights. The transom above the door has been infilled with brick, though the original lintel remains and features rosettes. The second story window opening contains triple 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows. The original opening has been partially infilled with brick. A string course, composed of two-course, stretcher-bond brick spans the façade beneath the second story windows. The third story openings contain 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with stone sills and lintels. A two-course, stretcher-bond brick string course stretches across the façade at the same level as the third story sills.

A three-story ell is located on the northeast corner of the rear (north) elevation of the building and is original to the main block. A three-story addition is located on the rear elevation of the ell and was constructed ca. 1980. The wood-frame addition is clad with vinyl siding and is capped by a sloping roof. The foundation was not visible from the public right-of-way. Fenestration consists of 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with square-edged vinyl surrounds and a single-leaf metal door.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. The building is adjacent to 1320 and 1324 H Street, NE. A paved public alley provides access to the rear of the property. The rear yard has been paved and is enclosed with a low, concrete retaining wall.

May 2009: Constructed in 1893, this three-story, two-bay building is one of two buildings constructed by John H. Nolan. The building is constructed of brick and is set on a solid brick foundation; both are faced with stretcher-bond brick. A sloping roof caps the building, though the roofing material was not visible from the public right-of-way. A cornice projects from the façade (south elevation) and is sited above a string course composed of recessed rowlock bricks. The first story of the façade has been altered since its construction. The easternmost features a round-headed opening with a soldier brick round-headed arch. The westernmost opening holds paired one-light metal windows. The transom above the door has been infilled with brick, though the original lintel remains and features rosettes. A second story, rectangular bay projects from the façade and has a shed roof. The wood-frame projecting bay holds two 1/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows and features wood paneling. A two-course, stretcher-bond brick string course spans the façade beneath the second story windows. The third story openings hold 1/1, double-hung, metal-sash windows with stone lintels and sills. A two-course, stretcher-bond brick string course stretches across the façade at the same level as the third story sills.

A three-story brick ell is located on the rear of the building and is original to the building. A three-story addition is located on the rear elevation of the ell and was constructed ca. 1980. The wood-frame ell is clad with vinyl siding and stretches the width of the building. A sloping roof caps the addition. The foundation was not discernible from the public right-of-way. Fenestration consists of 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows and single-leaf metal doors. Metal fire escapes provide access to each level of the rear elevation.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. The building is adjacent to 1322 A & B and 1326 H Street, NE. A public paved alley is located north of the building and provides access to the rear of the property. Concrete block walls and a metal chain-link fence enclose the rear of the property.

May 2009: Constructed in 1904, this two-story, three-bay building is constructed of brick and is set on a solid concrete foundation. The façade (south elevation) is faced with stretcher-bond brick and the west (side) elevation is constructed of five-course, American-bond brick. The foundation of the west elevation is parged. A sloping roof caps the building. The west and rear (north) elevations have been raised with brick parapet walls and are covered with metal flashing. An ogee-molded cornice with scrolled modillions and end brackets complements the roof. An interior chimney rises from the northeast corner of the building and has a parged cap. The end bays of the first story of the façade contain single-leaf metal-frame glass doors with one-light metal transoms and concrete lintels. The central opening holds paired one-light fixed metal windows with a concrete lintel. The end bays of the second story hold 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows and the central opening contains paired 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows. All second story windows have concrete sills and lintels. The west elevation does not have any fenestration. The easternmost bay of the rear elevations first story has been infilled with concrete blocks and the westernmost bay with brick. The easternmost bay of the second story holds a 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash window with a concrete lintel and the westernmost bay holds a single-leaf metal door. The original transom of the door has been infilled with wood. All openings retain two-course, rowlock brick segmental arches. Metal stairs provide access to the second story door.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. The east (side) elevation of the building is adjacent to 1360 H Street, NE and an asphalt alley is sited to the west. A paved public alley is located north of the building and provides access to the rear of the property. The rear yard is paved.

May 2009: Constructed in 1892, this two-story, three-bay building is constructed of brick and is set on a solid concrete foundation. The façade (south elevation) is faced with nine-course, American-bond brick and the east (side) elevation is constructed with seven-course, American-bond brick. A sloping roof caps the building and features metal flashing. An ogee-molded cornice with a corbeled brick cornice finish the roof. The westernmost bay of the façade has been boarded with plywood. The easternmost bay holds a single-leaf metal door. A one-story bay projects from the center of the façade and is wood-frame construction. The openings of the bay have been boarded with plywood. A flat roof caps the bay and it extends eastward to shelter the end bay. The original transoms are still visible. The end bays feature soldier brick segmental arches with molded brick lintel hoods. The central transom has a two-course, rowlock brick segmental arch. The second story window openings hold 2/2, double-hung, wood-sash windows with concrete sills and soldier brick segmental arches with molded brick lintel hoods. A two-course, stretcher-bond brick string course spans the façade at the sill level of the second story. A second string course, composed of alternating projecting and recessed header bricks flanked by stretcher-bond bricks, stretches across the façade above the second story windows. All of the window openings on the east elevation have been boarded with plywood, however, all retain concrete sills and soldier brick segmental arches with molded brick lintel hoods. The second story of the rear (north) elevation has two openings. The easternmost bay has been boarded with plywood. The westernmost bay contains a 1/1, double-hung, metal-sash window with a two-course, rowlock brick segmental arch.

A one-story addition is located on the rear elevation of the building and was constructed ca. 1950. The addition is constructed of irregularly-course, American-bond brick. A shed roof caps the addition and is covered with metal sheeting. The east elevation is pierced by two window openings, which have been boarded with plywood. The windows still have concrete sills.

A garage is no longer sited at the rear of the property.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. The west (side) elevation of the building is adjacent to 1360 H Street, NE and a brick and concrete alley is located to the east. Metal chain-link fencing encloses the rear yard.

The entire building has been clad with Permastone. The roofing type was not visible from the public right-of-way. The westernmost bay of the façade (south elevation) contains a single-leaf metal door with one-light and a one-light metal transom. The canted southeast corner of the building is pierced by a single-leaf metal-frame glass door. A two-story, rectangular bay projects from the east elevation and is original to and shares the same material treatment as the main block. The original first story openings have been altered and now hold a single-leaf metal door and a one-light fixed wood window. The second story openings hold a 2/2, double-hung, wood-sash window and a 1/1, double-hung, wood-sash window. Both windows have concrete sills and Permastone segmental arches.

A flat roof caps it. Fenestration is made up of a single-leaf paneled wood door with a one-light transom above and a window that was hidden by nearby plastic containers. The entry is protected by a metal security storm door and metal bars cover the window.

May 2009: This building was originally addressed as 1332 H Street, NE and is a part of a group of three identical buildings constructed by W.H. Abbott in 1914. It is now identified as 1328 H Street and is associated with 1326 H Street, which is located to the west. The two-story, three-bay building is currently used as commercial space (now vacant), however permits state that the building was originally a dwelling. The structure is made of brick and is set on a solid concrete foundation. The façade and foundation are veneered in stretcher-bond brick. A false mansard roof covered in painted octangular shingles partially obscure the sloping roof. It is flanked by brick firewalls and is finished with a wood cornice featuring modillions and a frieze. The second story windows are finished with concrete lug lintels and concrete sills, which extend into a brick sill course. Above the first story on the façade is an exposed I-beam.

The original rear ell is obscured by a two-bay addition that was constructed after 1960. Most of the addition stands two stories in height; however, the westernmost bay is only one story. It is constructed of concrete block with the north elevation clad in vinyl siding. A shed roof caps it, but the material treatment was not clearly discernable. Fenestration on the north elevation is made up of 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows on the second story and one-light casement or awning windows on the first story. The second story windows have metal security bars.

May 2009: This building is a part of a group of three identical buildings constructed by W.H. Abbott in 1914. The two-story, three-bay building is currently used as commercial space; however building permits state that the building was originally a dwelling. The structure is made of brick and is set on a solid concrete foundation. The façade and foundation are veneered in stretcher-bond brick. A false mansard roof covered in painted octangular shingles obscure the sloping roof. The false mansard roof is flanked by brick firewalls. It is finished with a wood cornice featuring modillions and a frieze. It features a blind front-gabled wall dormer. The dormer features a wood levered vent and the front gable is finished with cornice returns. From the public right-of-way, it appears that an exterior-end brick chimney located in the northwest corner of the main block is shared with the adjoining building at 1328 H Street. The first story of the facade is fenestrated by a centrally-placed single-leaf glass door in a metal frame with a one-light transom above. Paired one-light metal storefront windows flank the entry. The second story has a 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash window flanked by one-light metal fixed or casement windows. The second story windows are finished with concrete lug lintels and concrete sills, which extend into a brick sill course. Above the first story on the façade is a wide concrete string course.

Off the north (rear) elevation of the main block is an original two-story brick ell. The north (rear) elevation of the second story has 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete sills and segmental brick arches.

A one-story extension, which may be original, is located on the north (rear) elevation of the ell. It features five-course, Flemish-bond brick work and is capped by a shed roof. Two openings on the north elevation have been infilled with concrete block.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This property is located on the north side of H Street, NE. The commercial building fronts a concrete sidewalk. It is flanked by two buildings that were originally identical to each other. The rear yard, which is accessed by a public alley, is paved in concrete to allow for parking.

May 2009: This two-and-a-half-story building is two bays wide and was constructed in 1922 by Abraham Furman. It was designed by architect A.S.J. Atkinson. The rowhouse is constructed of five-course, American-bond brick and is veneered on the façade with stretcher-bond brick. The mansard roof is covered with square-butt slate shingles and is finished with overhanging eaves, and an ogee-molded cornice with modillions and a stepped parapet serving as a firewall on the side elevations. A stringcourse consisting of a course of soldier bricks flanked by single courses of rowlock bricks serves as a continuous lintel for the first-story openings. The main entry of the building is deeply recessed on the façade (south elevation) and contains a replacement single-leaf flush metal door with a single light. It has a square-edge wood surround and an ogee-molded lintel. An air conditioning unit replaces the transom. Glass blocks in the shape of a cross are located to the east of entry. The secondary entry on the façade is located in the easternmost bay. It consists of a replacement single-leaf flush metal door with a one-light transom. The second story of the façade is fenestrated with three 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete lug sills and flat arches with keystones. A stringcourse of soldier bricks is located at the lintel level. Each opening has a stacked brick surround. The west (side) elevation is fenestrated with single and paired 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows. All have concrete lug sills. All of the openings with the exception of the window illuminating the half-story have a segmental brick arch consisting of two courses of rowlock bricks. The paired opening on the first story holds stained glass windows and is protected by metal security bars. The second story of the rear elevation is fenestrated with two replacement single-leaf flush doors with transoms that have been boarded and a 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash window with rowlock brick sills and metal security bars. Both the door and window openings have segmental brick arches. The first-story openings were obscured by a wooden privacy fence, but segmental brick arches were visible.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This rowhouse is located on the north side of H Street, NE. It fronts directly onto the sidewalk. A public alley is located on the side (west) and the rear (north) of the building. The back yard is enclosed with wood privacy fencing and metal chain-link fencing. The building is one of three identical rowhouses (1366, 1368, 1370 H Street, NE) and is attached on the east side to 1368 H Street, NE.

The second story of the rear (north) elevation is fenestrated with 1/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows with two-course, rowlock brick segmental arches. Additionally, a single-leaf paneled wood door with lights and a single-leaf paneled wood door feature a three-light transom and two-course, rowlock brick segmental arches.

May 2009: This two-and-a-half-story building is three bays wide and was designed by architect A.S.J. Atkinson and constructed in 1922 by Abraham Furman. The rowhouse is constructed of five-course, American-bond brick and is veneered on the façade with stretcher-bond brick. The mansard roof is covered with square-butt slate shingles and is finished with overhanging eaves, a boxed cornice with scrolled metal brackets, a plain frieze, and a stepped parapet serving as a firewall on the side elevations. The dormer holds a large 16-light fixed wood window that is flanked by narrow 4/4, double-hung, wood-sash windows. It consists of a recessed cant entrance. The central entry, a single-leaf, wood-frame commercial door with metal security bars, is flanked by three-sided canted bays. Each face of the bay holds a single fixed window. The door and the bays are capped by a large two-light transom and are sheltered by a flat roof with overhanging eaves. A secondary entry is located in the westernmost bay of the façade. The single-leaf flush metal door is topped by a transom that has been boarded. A stringcourse of soldier bricks flanked by rowlock bricks serves as a continuous lintel for the first-story openings. The second story is fenestrated with 6/6, double-hung, wood-sash windows with concrete lug sills, flat arches with keystones, and stacked brick surrounds. A stringcourse of soldier bricks is located at the lintel level.

Circa 1965, the two-story porch on the rear elevation was enclosed. Clad with vinyl siding, the enclosed porch is capped by a flat roof with overhanging, boxed eaves. A single-leaf flush wood door with a single diamond-shaped light is located on the rear. The privacy fence obscures the rear of both the main block and addition.

May 2009: This two-story, two-bay building was constructed as a rowhouse. It now has a commercial unit on the first story with dwelling space on the second story. It is part of a row of four identical buildings that were constructed in 1892. The building, including the solid foundation is constructed of brick. The façade is veneered in stretcher-bond brick. A long piece of plywood spans the façade and divides the first and second stories. The sloping roof is obscured by brick parapet wall finished with an ogee-molded cornice, a corbeled brick cornice and brick string course. The first story of the façade has a single-leaf metal door protected by a metal security storm door in the westernmost bay. The center bay holds a 4/4, double-hung, wood-sash window and the easternmost bay has a paired 8/8, double-hung wood-sash window; each featuring a concrete sill and protected by metal security bars. The second story has 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete sills and soldier brick segmental arches. The east and west (side) elevation are obscured by adjacent buildings.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This property is located on the north side of H Street, NE. The building fronts a concrete sidewalk. The rear yard was not accessible. The building is adjacent to 1380 H Street, which is located to the east, and 1376 H Street, which is located to the west.

May 2009: In 1928, a one-story, two-bay garage was constructed north of the building. Set on a solid concrete foundation, the garage is constructed of irregularly coursed American-bond brick. The flat roof is obscured by a low parapet edged with a course of rowlock bricks. The garage is fenestrated with a metal roll-up door. No other openings were visible on the garage. The 1960 Sanborn Insurance Map indicates that the garage was once used as an auto repair shop.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

May 2009: Constructed in 1913 by Walter B. Avery, this building was designed by architect Claughton West for Charles H. Franzoni. Although the building permit refers to this as an apartment building, it appears that it was constructed as a double-front building with show window, commercial entries, and a central residential entry which provided access to the upstairs apartments. The 1928 Sanborn Insurance Map indicates the first story was used as two commercial businesses. The two-story building is three bays wide and sits on a solid concrete foundation. It is constructed of five-course, American-bond brick and is faced with stretcher-bond brick on the façade (south elevation). The flat roof is finished with a parapet with a round arch and a single course of header bricks serving as a cornice. A blind oculi with four keystones is centrally located in the arch. Four interior brick chimneys with plain caps pierce the roof and are visible from the alley. The chimneys at the outermost corners have been parged. A stringcourse of soldier bricks creates a continuous lintel for the first-story openings, while a second stringcourse of soldier bricks is located above the second-story fenestration. Two commercial storefronts, each with their own separate entry, flank the main entry to the building. The main residential entry consists of a replacement single-leaf metal door with a three-light transom. It is set in a segmentally arched brick surround with a keystone. The door is sheltered by a shed roof (material not visible) with overhanging eaves and an ogee-molded cornice with a paneled frieze. The commercial storefronts are each two bays wide, consisting of a single-leaf entry at the outermost bay and a show window. The show windows project onto the concrete sidewalk. They rest on solid foundations faced with stretcher-bond brick. The western commercial entry consists of a single-leaf wood door with a single light. The transom has been boarded with plywood. The storefront consists of two large fixed lights capped by a shed roof that extends over the single-leaf entry. The roof is supported by two square piers. The transom above the commercial windows has been boarded with wood. The eastern storefront is similar. The single-leaf wood door is paneled with nine lights. The multi-light wood transom extends above the entry and the storefront windows. It has been partially boarded with wood. The storefront windows hold two large fixed lights. They are set in an ogee-molded wood surround with bull's-eye corner blocks. The shed roof has overhanging eaves and an ogee-molded cornice with modillions. The second story is fenestrated with a single wood window (fixed or casement). It has a concrete lug sill and a soldier-brick lintel with a segmental arch with keystone. Moldings flanking the window have been removed. Two large oriels flank the central window opening. The three-sided oriels are fenestrated with 1/1 and 6/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows on the western oriel and single wood casement windows on the eastern oriel. Some of the openings on the eastern oriel have been boarded with wood. The oriels have half-hipped roofs (material not visible) with overhanging eaves, an ogee-molded cornice with dental molding, and a fluted frieze. Each window is set in a square-edged surround with a keystone, is topped by an ornamental arabesque panel, and rests on a paneled spandrel with a circular motif. The rear (north) and side (east and west) elevations are fenestrated with single openings with a three-course segmental brick arch and paired window openings with a single course of rowlock bricks serving as a lintel. All openings on the secondary elevations have a brick rowlock sill. The openings hold 1/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows or have been boarded with wood.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. This building is attached on both sides to 1348 and 1354 H Street, NE. A public alley is located north of the building and runs from east to west, providing access to the rear of the dwelling and to the detached garage that fronts the alley.

May 2009: The Robert L. Christian Community Library at 1300 H Street, N.E. was the first of four portabranh community libraries built in the District of Columbia between 1981 and 1993. The portabranh program, initiated in 1974, planned for the construction of compact, pre-fabricated, portable library facilities in neighborhoods where current branch services did not reach. Opened in May 1, 1981, the R. L. Christian Community Library replaced a storefront library branch established under the Model Cities program in 1972. The program's goal was to bring library services to designated "Model Neighborhoods" that were historically under-served by the library. The Model Cities areas loosely consisted of the Shaw, Trinidad, and Stanton Park neighborhoods. The new branch library, located on the northeast corner of H and 13th streets, N.E., serves the communities of Trinidad and Stanton Park. The building was funded through the D.C. Public Library's construction budget, and consisted of a pre-fabricated steel and glass building designed by PortaStructures Industries, Inc. as an economical, space-saving alternative to permanent library branches. This building has an irregular form marked by shed roofs extending from the center of the building in seven directions. The southwest corner of the building is recessed, and as such, has no roof. The library is marked by narrow, two-light metal-sash windows, canted elevations softened by projecting rounded bays with display windows, over-hanging eaves, and an elevated central block with pyramidal-roofed. Entry to the building is via two, single-leaf door openings with metal-frame glass doors located on the H Street, NE elevation.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located on a corner lot northeast of the intersection of H Street, NE and 13th Street, NE. The property extends northward to be bound by Wylie Street, NE. The building directly fronts the concrete sidewalk along H Street, NE. The property has been minimally landscaped with planting beds. A flagpole is located in the southwest corner of the building, within the recessed corner of the building. A triangular-shaped metal sign with metal supports surrounds the flagpole. A small grassy area is located north of the building and is enclosed by a chain-link fence.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

May 2009: Constructed in 1902, this two-story, two-bay building was originally one of two similar buildings constructed by Thomas H. Melton. The other building is adjacent at 1320 H Street, NW. The building was constructed as mixed-use with commercial operations on the first story and residential on the second story. The building is constructed of brick and is set on a solid concrete foundation. The façade (south elevation) is faced with stretcher-bond brick while the west and north elevations have irregular American-bond brick. A sloping roof caps the building though the roofing material was not visible from the public right-of-way. An interior brick chimney with plain cap pierces the roof. The roof features a brick parapet wall with molded cornice flanked by molded caps. Projecting brick panels highlight the parapet. The façade (south elevation) has a single-leaf door opening in the western bay. The opening is covered with plywood and protected by a metal-frame security door. The eastern bay holds large metal-sash storefront windows set behind a metal grille. The second story has three window openings with two-course, rowlock brick lancet arches. The openings have limestone sills but have been covered with plywood. A molded architrave with dentils and small rosettes beneath is located above the second-story window openings. The west (side) elevation has no fenestration. The two-story rear ell is fenestrated by 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with two-course, rowlock brick segmental arches.

May 2009: This building is located on the north side of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. The east (side) elevation is attached to 1320 H Street, NE and a paved driveway to the west. A large parking lot is located north of the lot and provides access to the rear of the property, which is enclosed with a chain-link fence.

May 2009: This stable was constructed in 1892 and spans the width of the lot. The brick structure has a sloping roof of poured concrete. The roof has a balustrade of lattice. The north (rear) elevation contains a single-leaf metal door and a large opening that has been enclosed with concrete block.

Exterior & Architectural Notes:

May 2009: Constructed in 1900, this two-story, three-bay building was constructed by William Chukers. The building was constructed as a single-family dwelling. The 1928 Sanborn Fire Insurance Company map documents the building as a dwelling, however, by 1960 the building is a store. At the time of the 2009 on-site survey, the building appeared to support commercial operations on the first story and residential on the second. The brick building has rectangular form with a rear ell. The façade (south elevation) is faced with stretcher-bond brick while the secondary elevations are faced with five-course, American-bond brick. A sloping roof caps the building, though the roofing material was not visible from the public right-of-way due to a parapet wall and tapered brick party walls. The parapet features a prominent corbeled brick table with corbeled brick brackets and a molded metal cornice with rosettes. An exterior-rear brick chimney extends from the north (rear) elevation. Based on its materials, this chimney is either non-historic or has been rebuilt. The façade (south elevation) has been altered significantly. A single-leaf metal door is located in the west bay with a tile surround. East of the door opening is a large opening obscured from view by an upward coiling security gate. A projecting wood-frame hood spans the width of the elevation. The hood is clad in tiles. The second story window openings have been partially enclosed with brick and replacement 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows installed. The openings have large rock-faced lintels. A metal sign has been attached in front of the middle bay. A string course of stretcher bricks and rowlock bricks extends above the second-story window openings. The west (side) elevation has no fenestration, however, a weathered building advertisement remains. The rear ell features a door opening that has been enclosed with brick and a window opening. The window opening has been partially enclosed with brick and a 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash window installed. The window opening has a rowlock brick flat arch.

Site Notes:

May 2009: This building is located north of H Street, NE and directly fronts the concrete sidewalk. The building is adjacent to 1342 H Street, NE to the west and 1346-1348 H Street, NE to the east. The building fronts a large parking area to the north.
