Exterior & Architectural Notes:

March 2008: Constructed in 1928 by D.C. Gruver, this two-story, two-bay rowhouse is one of twelve similar dwellings constructed from the same permit (#5841). Designed by George T. Santmyers, the Colonial Revival-style rowhouse was influenced by the Craftsman Style. Set on a solid concrete foundation, this brick dwelling is faced with five-course, American-bond brick. Multiple brick stringcourses ornament the façade. A false mansard and pent roof of slate shingles roof caps the dwelling and has overhanging eaves with exposed rafter ends. A shed dormer is located on the mansard and holds eight-light wood windows. The dwelling is fenestrated with 6/6, double-hung, wood-sash windows with concrete sills. The primary entry is located on the façade (east elevation) and holds a single-leaf, paneled wood door with lights surmounted by a single-light transom. A one-story, two-bay porch projects from the façade and sits on a foundation of brick piers infilled with wood lattice. The flat roof of the porch is supported by metal filigree posts and the porch is encircled by metal balusters.

The side (south) elevation received the same material treatment as the façade. A three-sided rectangular bay projects from this elevation, and the foundation is fenestrated with sliding metal windows with concrete sills. A brick chimney with a plain cap is visible from this elevation. A two-story, full-width enclosed porch is located on the rear (west) elevation. The first story has been parged and the second story is faced with aluminum siding. The foundation is pierced by a roll-up garage door on the south elevation. The porch is capped by a shed roof and fenestrated with 6/6 and 1/1, double-hung, wood-sash windows. A single-leaf door is sheltered by a vinyl awning on the west elevation.

Site Notes:

March 2008: This two-story, end-unit rowhouse is located on the west side of 17th Street, N.E. and is set back approximately fifteen feet from the public concrete sidewalk. The raised, grassy front yard is marked by small shrubs and is surrounded by a brick retaining wall and a chain-link metal fence. A concrete walkway provides access to the property from the public sidewalk. The backyard is enclosed by a tall wood privacy fence. A driveway enters the property from Constitution Avenue, N.E. to the south.

March 2008: Constructed in 1928 by D.C. Gruver, this two-story, two-bay rowhouse is one of twelve similar dwellings constructed from the same permit (#5841). Designed by George T. Santmyers, the Colonial Revival-style rowhouse was influenced by the Craftsman Style. Set on a solid concrete foundation, this brick dwelling is faced with five-course, American-bond brick. Multiple brick stringcourses ornament the façade. A sloping roof caps the dwelling and is complemented on the façade (east elevation) by a false mansard and pent roof of slate shingles with overhanging eaves and exposed rafter ends. A shed dormer is located on the mansard and holds eight-light wood windows. The dwelling is fenestrated with 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows with concrete sills. The primary entry is located on the façade and holds a single-leaf, paneled metal door with an oval light surmounted by a single-light transom. A one-story, one-bay porch projects from the façade and sits on a foundation of brick piers infilled with brick. The flat roof of the porch is supported by metal filigree posts and the porch is encircled by metal balusters.

A two-story, full-width wood-frame enclosed porch is located on the rear (west) elevation. The porch is faced with aluminum siding and is capped by a shed roof. The appendage is fenestrated with 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows sheltered by vinyl awnings. A single-leaf door with lights is located on the west elevation. An exterior-rear brick chimney with a parged cap is located on this elevation.

Site Notes:

March 2008: This two-story rowhouse is located on the west side of 17th Street, N.E. and is set back approximately fifteen feet from the public concrete sidewalk. The raised front yard is filled with rocks and tiered with a concrete-block retaining wall. The yard is marked by a mature tree and is surrounded by a brick retaining wall and a chain-link metal fence. A concrete walkway provides access to the property from the public sidewalk. The backyard is enclosed by a tall vinyl privacy fence and a concrete-paved parking pad is located west of the property.

March 2008: This one-story, one-bay garage is attached to the garage of 1649 C Street. The wood-frame structure was constructed ca. 1934 and has a shed roof. It is faced with aluminum siding and has a two-leaf wood door on the south elevation.

March 2008: Constructed in 1934 by John A. Jordan, this two-story, three-bay rowhouse is one of four similar dwellings constructed from the same permit (#173051). Designed by James D. McDonald, the Colonial Revival-style rowhouse is set on a concrete block foundation. The concrete block dwelling is faced with six-course, American-bond brick and is capped by a pent roof of slate shingles. A plain metal frieze with a molded metal cornice below completes the roof. Openings on the dwelling hold 1/1, double-hung, vinyl-sash windows—openings on the first story have rowlock brick sills and a header brick course runs below the second story openings. Openings on the foundation hold sliding vinyl windows. A one-story projecting bay is located on the façade and is shared with 1645 C Street. The bay received the same material treatment as the main block and is capped by front-gabled roof. This bay holds six-light wood windows with rowlock brick sills. The main entrance is located on the east elevation of the projecting bay and was not visible from the public right-of-way. A one-story, one-bay porch projects from the façade and has a shed roof of asphalt shingles. The roof is supported by square wood posts. The porch sits on a foundation faced with brick. All openings on the façade are sheltered by metal awnings.
