






DGS NET-ZERO PROJECTS






PROGRAMMATIC ACTIVITIES: EASTERN MARKET

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT: EASTERN MARKET METRO PLAZA

Through our collaboration with DPR, DDOT, DPW, and the Capitol Hill BID, we work together to maintain this community amenity.

Under the MOA, DPW, and the Capitol Hill BID (responsible for removing trash twice a day) are responsible for waste management.

DGS is responsible for recycling receptacles, performing mowing and landscaping services, and rodent abetment treatment.

In partnership with DPR, DGS is completing an Erosion Control Project to address paving, masonry, and more. We will share updates as they become available.
